



Horse Stamp Church Road Interchange Breaks Ground!

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Camden County issued the following news release:

Local officials, project managers, and engineers gathered together on Wednesday, November 03, 2010 after 12 years of planning, designing, and permitting Horse Stamp Church Road Interchange, or Exit 22 of I-95, to officially 'break ground' for the construction of this project. "This is an exciting day to see this project become a reality! Once complete, the new interchange presents enormous opportunities for Camden County's future," said Steve L. Howard, County Administrator.

Seaboard Construction & Roger's Bridge have teamed together and been awarded the contract for this project for \$10.9 million. Moreland Altobelli & Associates has performed the services of Project Justification, Concept Design, Right-of-Way Services, Environmental Permitting, and Final Design. Construction of the project is expected to take 24 months with the Georgia Department of Transportation overseeing.

Craig Brack and Camden County Joint Development Authority originally administered this project, with Camden County Public Works finalizing the project coordination with Moreland Altobelli & Associates.

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
